The HALLWAY

- The hallway walls are painted in Dulux Pine Needle with a complementary wallpaper applied in certain places.



Storage seating

- This preloved piece of furniture was dark brown has been repainted with Annie Sloan chalk paint and sealed with wax.
- Caster wheels were added for easier movement
- Even these cushion pockets are preloved. And the little handle thrown in, so it opened in a different way.



Top landing

- Not only was the walls painted in the Dulux paint, but this was also added to the stairs and handrails. Again, you see the wallpaper only on facing wall as you walk up the stairs.
- I love that the large mirror is reflecting the wallpaper too.
- The small pink cupboard throws in a shade from the wallpaper.



The wooden vase

- The wooden vase adds a nice touch.



THE LIVING ROOM

- The wall colour is Dulux Copper Blush, it's a warm cozy colour which complements the teal accent on the door frame.
- The artwork is a personal piece, I love working on canvas when I can.
- The orange lampshade is a basket upside down and the stand originally grey painted too lights up beautifully.






Still in the Living room

- The sliding doors once white, have been painted in Dulux Teal Voyage, then panelled with wallpaper from Dunelm. The top trim is finished with Crown Crafted Metallic Copper.
- The collection of vases sits on a second-hand office shelving unit. This has been sanded back and painted with the teal colour and sealed with Annie Sloan clear wax.

- The feature wallpaper is from a wide roll paper and patterns parrots, a talking piece when guest come around.



The Dining Table

- The dining table, a G-plan table that came with the house 16 years ago. I've decorated the top a few times. This latest design applied is using heavy duty lining paper, then applying cream silk paint. Once completely dry I then stencilled short quotes to aid dinner discussions, and it works.



The other side of the sliding doors. Fitted with large black door handles , makes it easier to open. Added to finished off with off cuts of our parrot wallpaper.





The dining room bar. The preloved cabinet is as beautifully simple. I painted the inside pink and frame orange. When friends are around, we pull up seating and drink responsibly.



Revamp lamp and Shade

- Applying Annie Sloan chalk paint and wax, completely changed this once tired cream lamp into new.

Dining room cosy corner

- This corner is where you relax, read a book or just chill while looking at the sky.
- The chaise lounge was found in IKEA barging basement over 10 years ago. It is quite heavy, so I took off frame and added industrial wheels.
- The orange cover wraps around the whole chaise, the squashy cushions and warm blankets makes this space dreamy.



The Shower Curtain

- These shower curtains match the space perfectly. I call these my summer covering, changing to heavy ones in winter.

- With the sliding doors open you see how the two spaces become one. How the colours work together.
- I open the space up in the summer months, as it's great for entertaining.
