





Revamped & Repurpose.


An introduction project.

Repair & Revamp and Repaint
This broken dressing table mirror, was one of the most challenge pieces brought in. It was carefully pulled apart and repaired, revamped and repainted with chalk paint and sealed with wax.







Upcycle and Repurpose

This broken bird feeder was repaired and revamped with paint to look like a mushroom. This participant signature design.






She loved art but said only on paper. Found this old glass jar. Now, revamped into a candle holder. Using chalk paint to do the artwork.




A simple coffee container, revamped with off cut from a discontinued wallpaper sample book, now a storage container.


